

# St. Vrain Greenway - Phase 6



Phase 6 of the St. Vrain Greenway involved public facilitation, trail layout, and construction documents to extend the existing multi-use trail system eastward an additional 1.9 miles through the southern portion of the City of Longmont. An important trail system within Boulder and Weld Counties as well as part of the Front Range Trail, the project involved a complex set of program elements, public agencies, and design consultants. Also, trail access had to be coordinated with several adjacent landowners. The trail extension included four bridge crossings and one underpass requiring close collaboration with the structural engineer. Landscape and irrigation were key to trail development to restore the natural beauty of the greenway after trail construction.

Kerry White was project manager for Phase 6 from design and layout through construction documentation. She prepared drawings for and presented information at the controversial yet successful public meetings. Recognizing the importance of continuity in the greenway system, she paid special attention to meeting City standards for trail cross sections, signage and site furnishings, maintenance needs, and future access and trail connections. Kerry's organization skills and attention to detail played an important part in the successful design and implementation of Phase 6 of the St. Vrain Greenway.
